Job Overview

Skippering wildlife adventure trips on 8.5m RIBs; ensuring an informative, safe and fun experience for our passengers. Establishing responsible and sustainable interactions with wildlife from the vessel.

The successful candidate must have a passion for marine wildlife and the marine environment. They should have an outgoing personality and the willingness to work flexible hours. After training all crew must be able to work in the ticket office and assist with boat preparation and maintenance.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Boat preparation & maintenance
- Skippering wildlife adventure trips on 8.5m RIBs. Responsible and sustainable interactions with wildlife from the vessel
- Maintaining vessels; cleaning, basic repairs, scheduling servicing, etc.
- Guiding wildlife trips- interacting with passengers regarding local wildlife, geography and history
- Safe vessel operations in a range of weather conditions

Qualifications/Experience

Required/essential:

- Keen interest in marine wildlife, with the ability to communicate this to passengers
- Powerboat driving experience. Minimum: Powerboat level 2 commercially endorsed (or be willing to train to this level and beyond)
- Guiding experience
- Ability to work independently and on a team

- Advanced Powerboat driver & Powerboat instructor
- Vessel & Outboard maintenance experience
